ernest hemingway was a mythic figure of overt masculinity and vibrant literary genius he lived life on an epic scale presenting to the world a character as compelling as the fiction he created but behind it all lurked an insecure troubled man in this immensely powerful and revealing study kenneth s lynn explores the many tragic facets that both nurtured hemingway s work and eroded his life masterfully written hemingway brings to life the writer whose desperate struggle to exorcise his demons produced some of the greatest american fiction of this century

ever wondered how walt disney and ernest hemingway rose to stardom walter elias disney was born in chicago illinois on december 5 1901 he was of german american ancestry and was one of five children four boys and a girl he developed a love of drawing and by 18 he became a draftsman at a kansas city art studio his very first job in the art world was at a small company where he met ub iwerks who turned out to be a fantastic animator later in his life so many years after his demise people endure to clutch his philosophies and his conceptions recalling him for everything he s done for them this memoir of ernest miller hemingway who was an american playwright and journalist is a remarkable piece of reading stuff for the readers his reasonable and modest panache had a robust impact on twentieth century literature while his existence of adventure and his community appearance will keep on having an effect on the subsequent generations to come hemingway shaped most of his literary work

my brother ernest hemingway was the only biography ernest knew about and he was pleased with it although he asked his brother to postpone publication while he was still alive first published in 1962 leicester's biography provides a revealing and intimate portrait of one of the great writers of our century ernest hemingway was a legend in his own time whose life was as dramatic as any of the characters in his novels and short stories he won both the nobel and the pulitzer prizes for literature and the literary style he created has been imitated but never matched leicester was the archetypal kid brother 16 years younger than the great man whom he adored and in whose footsteps he followed becoming a respected writer sharing his brother's love for high risk and adventure and when his health failed choosing to end his own life as ernest had done in this poignant biography leicester has given us insight into his world renowned brother's life and career as no one else could his reminiscences allow us to better understand what prompted so many of the familiar hemingway responses and the experiences from which he derived material for his novels and stories

in arguably his most famous work ernest hemingway wrote a man can be destroyed

but not defeated it is perhaps this single line from the old man and the sea that gives the most insight into the mind of one of the greatest writers in american history hemingway was a man who rejected defeat at every opportunity he was a man whose desire to be the best won him respect but also lost him friends he lived his life the way he wanted rarely stopping to apologize even in death hemingway proved his determination trying to take his own life at least twice before he ultimately succeeded with the final blast of a shotgun hemingway served as an ambulance driver for the red cross in wwi while in italy on duty he decided that he was not near enough to the action and went closer to the front just as he got to the front an enemy mortar shell exploded in close proximity to hemingway despite being injured in the blast ernest found a young italian soldier who was severely hurt and carried him to safety taking several rounds of machine gun fire to his leg for his bravery hemingway was awarded the italian silver medal of valor while in the hospital still recovering from his injuries hemingway fell in love with a nurse named agnes von kurowsky ernest had to return to america but he vowed that one day he would marry von kurowsky it was not to be however as hemingway received a letter only months after returning home saying that his love had fallen for an italian officer he was devastated and his initial broken heart may explain why he made a habit out of leaving women before they could leave him hemingway was married four times and had affairs in each of his marriages
